BYLAW NO. 7022

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE DELEGATION OF
COUNCIL EXECUTIVE AND ADMINISTRATIVE POWERS

WHEREAS the Mayor has established a Standing Committee pursuant to Section 141 of the *Community Charter* known as the "Finance/Policy Committee of the Whole".

AND WHEREAS Section 154 of the *Community Charter* provides that the Council may by bylaw, delegate its powers, duties and functions, including those specifically established by enactment, to the extent provided, to a Standing Committee;

AND WHEREAS the Council desires to delegate its executive and administrative powers to the "Finance/Policy Committee of the Whole".

THEREFORE the Council of the City of Nanaimo, in open meeting assembled, HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This bylaw may be cited as the "DELEGATION OF COUNCIL POWERS BYLAW 2006 NO. 7022".
2. All of the executive and administrative powers of Council are hereby delegated to the "Finance/Policy Committee of the Whole".
3. The procedure of the "Finance/Policy Committee of the Whole" shall be governed as provided for in "COUNCIL PROCEDURE BYLAW 2005 NO. 7007" and amendments thereto.

REPEAL

4. "DELEGATION OF COUNCIL POWERS BYLAW 1994 NO. 4759" is hereby repealed.
