The Vancouver Island Animal Defense League is hosting a public forum to discuss non-lethal ways of approaching the issue of Nanaimo's urban deer.

Most of us would agree that the deer are not safe where they are now. Deer are competing for turf with humans and as many as 30 a month are being hit by cars, usually in North Nanaimo.

It may be in the best interests of the deer community itself for some to be sterilized or for animals to be relocated away from neighbourhoods where they have become too numerous. *What do you think?*

The provincial government may decide to go ahead with a deer cull and we need to discuss humane alternatives. Views expressed at the forum will be forwarded to Nanaimo City Council.
